L&T Secures Rs. 215 Cr. (USD 51.7 million) Order for 33 kV Underground Cabling in UAE

Mumbai, May 8, 2007: Larsen & Toubro Limited (L&T) has secured an order valued at Rs. 215 crore (USD 51.7 million and AED 189.93 million) from the Abu Dhabi Water & Electricity Authority for the supply and installation of 33 kV power cables and fibre optic cables for inter connecting various substations in the eastern region of Abu Dhabi.

L&T will supply and install 33 kV cables and fibre optic cables as per the specification of international consultant, Lahmeyer International GmbH.

The scope of the underground cabling contract includes design, manufacture, supply, installation as well as testing and commissioning of 33 kV cables and fibre optic cables including associated civil works, covering 11 substations for the reinforcement of the power distribution network to meet the increase in power demand from the current and new customers.

The contract will be executed within 18 months.
