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L&T Wins ₹ 749 Crore Contract from ONGC for 4 Wellhead Platforms

Mumbai, August 27, 2012: Larsen & Toubro has secured an offshore contract valued at ₹ 749 crore from the Oil & Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC) for total 'EPCI' - Engineering Procurement Construction & Installation of four wellhead platforms. The contract was won against international competitive bidding.

The project, spread over the Mukta, Bassein and Mumbai High South fields is part of ONGC's strategy to develop marginal fields to meet India's rising energy demands. L&T is scheduled to complete the project by April, 2014. In addition to conventional wellhead facilities, one of the platforms, viz., the B-127, will also have process gas compression facility.

L&T has been serving the upstream hydrocarbon sector since early the '90s. This contract reiterates the long term association of ONGC with L&T in the development of offshore fields in India.
