Mr A.M.Naik, L&T CMD, conferred Gujarat's Highest State Honour

Ahmedabad, January 13, 2009, The Government of Gujarat conferred the Gujarat Garima (Pride of Gujarat) award on Mr A.M.Naik, Chairman & Managing Director, Larsen & Toubro, at a glittering ceremony on the opening day of the Vibrant Gujarat Global Investors' Summit in Ahmedabad. This is the highest civilian honour awarded by the Government of Gujarat.

Gujarat Chief Minister Mr. Narendra Modi presented the award, comprising of a shawl and a citation, to Mr. Naik in the presence of his council of ministers, legislators, visiting state guests and other dignitaries.
