SNS Ranks 11th on Construction Week's Power 100 List

Deemed one of the Middle East's
Most Influential Construction Leaders of 2021



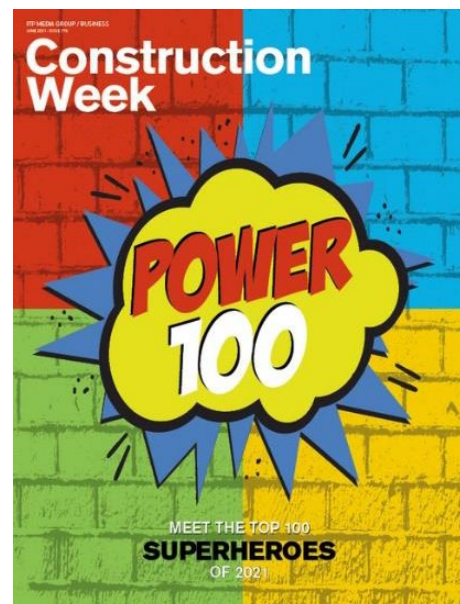
Moving up two spots, L&T's CEO & MD Mr S N Subrahmanyan has ranked 11th on Construction Week's prestigious Power 100 List released in its latest issue. The list features Middle East's 100 Most Influential Construction Leaders of 2021.

Earlier this year, Mr Subrahmanyan was appointed Chairman of the National Safety Council by India's Ministry of Labour and Employment. He also featured in the Utilities Middle East's list of the Top 50 Most Influential People in the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) utilities industries.

Construction Week says under Mr Subrahmanyan's leadership L&T has grown to be one of the biggest contractors in the GCC Region where it has secured some of the major design-and-build as well as engineering, procurement & construction contracts. Most recently, L&T commenced construction work on Saudi Arabia's 300 MW Jeddah Solar PV project in Third Jeddah Industrial City.

The publication has commended L&T's prompt action to mitigate the impact of the pandemic on its environment, health & safety systems, highlighting that the Company chose to digitalise and innovate in order to re-evaluate and re-orient itself to face the new normal. It reported that L&T put in place processes to maintain real-time communication - downward, upward and horizontal - as it continues to use AI to monitor its projects.

100 rankings were based on publicly available information and entries submitted concerning the performances of the companies over the past 12 months, including revenue, scale of project delivery, how they have overcome challenges and what initiatives they have taken to boost prospects, awards and future plans.
