

L&T Donates ₹9.4 Cr for Assam Flood Relief

L&T CEO & MD Mr S N Subrahmanyan (SNS), on 21 July, handed over the cheque to Assam CM Mr Himanta Biswa Sarma in Guwahati. SNS was accompanied by Mr D K Sen (Whole-time Director & Sr EVP - Development Projects, L&T) and others.



The amount constituted the employees' voluntary donation of half a day's salary, complemented by a matching contribution from the Company.

Mr Biswa Sarma expressed overwhelming gratitude to L&T for the generosity. "Grateful to Larsen & Toubro Limited for contributing ₹9,40,97,770 to CM Relief Fund. Most parts of Assam, especially the Barak Valley region, was battered by a devasting flood in the second half of June. So much so that Assam's second biggest urban hub - Silchar - was submerged for over a week.
